## **Fundraising Event Ideas for Wounded Warriors Family Support**

Art Auction: Showcase and auction off artwork donated by local artists to raise funds for WWFS.

**Bake Sale**: Sell delicious homemade treats and goodies to support WWFS's programs and services.

**Car Wash**: Offer a car wash service where participants can donate to WWFS while getting their cars cleaned.

**Car Show**: Host a local car show and collect entry fees or donations from attendees to support the mission of WWFS.

**Dance Marathon**: Organize a lively dance event where participants can gather sponsors and dance for an extended period to raise funds.

**Dog Show**: Throw a local dog show where community members can show off their pets. This is exceptionally fun for smaller communities to learn more about your neighbors.

**eBay Auction**: Set up an online auction on eBay, featuring donated items and experiences, with proceeds going to WWFS.

**Fashion Show**: Host a fashion show featuring local designers and models, with ticket sales and sponsorship proceeds benefiting WWFS.

Jean Day at Work: Everyone pays \$5 to wear jeans to work on Friday!

**Sell Wristbands**: Sell WWFS wristbands or create your own!

**Game Night**: Organize a game night with various board games and card games, charging an entry fee or donations to participate. Bingo and other games are very common options.

**Holiday Bazaar**: Host a festive bazaar where vendors sell holiday-themed crafts, gifts, and treats, with a portion of the proceeds supporting WWFS.

**Ice Cream Social**: At your next family or work event, have a sundae making station with proceeds benefiting WWFS.

**Jog-a-Thon**: Encourage participants to gather pledges for every lap they complete during a designated time period, supporting WWFS's cause.

**Karaoke Competition**: Host a karaoke competition where participants can showcase their singing talents and raise funds through entry fees or donations.

**Dinner Party**: Sell tickets and invite guests to a rented venue, a volunteer's home, or your office for a delicious potluck harvest dinner or cocktail hour. Prepare your pitch so guests will understand how meaningful this dinner and their contributions truly are.

**Music Concert**: Organize a music concert featuring local bands or artists, with ticket sales and sponsorships supporting WWFS.

**Neighborhood Garage Sale**: Encourage community members to hold garage sales on the same day, with a percentage of the sales donated to WWFS.

**Online Fundraising Campaign**: Launch a dedicated online fundraising campaign, leveraging social media platforms and email outreach to raise funds for WWFS. We have a number of tools to help you with this, including dedicated GiveButter donation pages.

**Pancake Breakfast**: Host a pancake breakfast event, where attendees can enjoy a delicious meal and contribute to WWFS through ticket sales or donations.

**Quilt Auction**: Collect handmade quilts from volunteers or local quilting groups and auction them off to raise funds for WWFS.

**Run for a Cause**: Organize a charity run or marathon, where participants can gather pledges and run to support WWFS.

**Sports Tournament**: Host a sports tournament, such as basketball, soccer, or volleyball, with team entry fees going towards WWFS.

**Streaming Fundraiser**: Invite those who follow your stream to donate to support WWFS's mission. There are several tools to help make this easy for you, such as Tiltify.

**"Donate Your Venmo Balance" Campaign**: Ask your network to donate the remaining balances in their Venmo accounts to your cause. With this type of fundraiser, every modest contribution accumulates to make a significant impact, allowing a collective effort to transform idle dollars into meaningful action.

**Wine and Cheese Tasting**: Host an elegant wine and cheese tasting event, partnering with local wineries and cheesemakers, with ticket sales benefiting WWFS.

**Yard Sale**: Encourage supporters to donate items for a yard sale, with all proceeds going towards WWFS's programs and services.

**Zoom Trivia Party**: Host a virtual trivia night using video conferencing platforms, charging a participation fee and offering prizes, while supporting WWFS.
